## ARTIST AGREEMENT

The purpose of this agreement is to outline the guidelines that will apply to the art exhibit from **September 15, 2014** through **September 15, 2015**.

1. Artwork must be set up between **August 15, 2014- September 15, 2014**(as locations become available) and removed by **September 15, 2015** unless other arrangements are made in advance with LCAT/JEDC.
2. The artist agrees to be responsible for installation and removal of their artwork and any cost associated with shipping or transportation of the artwork.
3. The LCAT/JEDC is open to the public therefore the artist certifies that his/her work is soundly and professionally constructed on durable and sturdy materials, has no breakable or easily damaged parts or pieces, is suitable for outdoor public display, is constructed in a way which will not cause safety or liability problems and will require no maintenance during the (12) twelve-month exhibit period.
4. **All artwork must be for sale.** Each sculpture must be a minimum height of 3' (three feet) tall. Artwork must be constructed with quality and safety in mind. In the event a piece of artwork is sold during the (12) twelve-month exhibit period, the artist agrees that LCAT/JEDC will receive **25%** of the retail price for commission. The process of the sale of the Artwork will be done by the LCAT/JEDC and the Artist will be paid **75%** of retail price within sixty (60) days of the sale. All artwork shall remain in place for the (12) twelve-month exhibit period. If an Artist artwork is sold during the (12) twelve-month exhibit period then the Artist can replace it with a similar one immediately upon approval.
5. The Artist will coordinate delivery of artwork with the purchaser. The LCAT/JEDC will provide the Artist with purchaser contact information within one week of purchase. Upon delivery, any artwork(s) deemed to be of poor quality or unsafe will be rejected and no money will be awarded to the artist.
6. **No artwork will be removed during the term for private sales without commission being paid to LCAT/JEDC.**
7. The LCAT/JEDC will do everything possible to safeguard an artist's property, however, its insurance will not cover artwork that is not owned by the facility. It is the Artist's responsibility to furnish insurance on their art work. Therefore, this document serves as a Waiver of Liability when exhibiting in the City of Jewett, Texas.
8. Photographs of the exhibited art works may be reproduced by LCAT/JEDC for promotional purposes.
