

2020 Jewett Quilt Show Entry Rules

1. Quilt Projects must fit into one of the Quilt Show Divisions.
2. All entry forms, money and a clear photo of the quilt/other item must be mailed to the address on entry form by **Monday, September 21, 2020**. NO late entries.
3. Quilts will be hung by pant hangers (no sleeves required).
4. All quilts/other items **must have a label on the back**. The label must include your name, the quilter's name, and date the item was finished. All quilts must be put in a cloth bag (like a pillowcase) with your name and phone number on it. One item per bag only.
5. There is a maximum of two quilts per person per category. The entry fee is \$10 each for the first two quilts and \$5 for each additional quilt.
6. No quilt that was entered in the 2018 Jewett Quilt Show is eligible for entry this year.
7. All quilts should be brought to the Jewett Civic Center on Wednesday September 30, 2020 between the hours of 9 am – 1 pm (no late deliveries will be accepted). You may also ship your quilt to the Jewett Area Chamber of Commerce via UPS or FedEx to 111 N. Robinson, Jewett, Texas 75846. If you use the US Postal Service, please ship to P.O. Box 220, Jewett, Texas 75846. Any quilt/item that is shipped must be received by Tuesday, September 29, 2020. The quilt committee will not be held responsible for the loss of any packages. Please include \$15.00 money order or check (payable to Jewett Area Chamber of Commerce) if you would like to have it shipped back to you as well.
8. Quilts must be picked up on Saturday, October 3, 2020 between 4:00 pm – 5:00 pm (no early pick up). You are welcome to wait in the adjoining Community Room while the committee goes through the process of taking down all quilts, checking them out, and putting your judge's papers along with any ribbons back in your bags. We will start calling you to the stage once all quilts are packed up and accounted for. Quilts left after 5:30 pm will be stored at the Jewett Area Chamber of Commerce office and no responsibility will be held by the Jewett Quilt Show staff or the Chamber.
9. The Show Chair reserves the right to re-categorize entries if it is determined they have been entered in the wrong category. Categories may be consolidated if there are insufficient entries in a category. The Chair may refuse the entry of distasteful items or items that fail to meet entry criteria. Every effort will be made to communicate any change to the quilt maker.
10. Each quilt maker will fill out an entry form for each quilt.
11. Awards will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and Honorable Mention winners in each category. A Viewer's Choice for both youth and adult divisions will be awarded at 2 p.m. on Saturday, October 3, 2020. Additionally, Judges Choice will be chosen by the Jewett Quilt Show Judge and awarded prior to the beginning of the Show. Both Viewer's Choice and Judge's Choice Winners will receive Gift Baskets along with award ribbons.
12. All quilts/other items must have been completed in the last three years.
13. Any quilts that are for sale will have an asterisk beside its name in the Jewett Quilt Show booklet and a placard will be placed next to the quilt with the sale information. Please mark your entry form accordingly in order to have your quilts listed appropriately.
14. ***NEW THIS YEAR*** A \$250 scholarship will be awarded to the Youth Ages 12-17 Judge's Choice.
